


BALTIMORE'S THIRD COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT





BECAUSE HAMPDEN MAIN STREET WAS **NOT REDESIGNED** FOR CARS...




COMPARISON: HAMPDEN MAIN STREET

FORMERLY "RED-LINED" COMMUNITIES




FORMERLY RED-LINED COMMUNITIES

- Eight communities in Baltimore have 50%+ household no-vehicle access


- These are the 8 historically red-lined communities that are majority Black today.

- Freeway construction and road-widening



FORMERLY RED-LINED COMMUNITIES

- Hyper-segregated: 6 are 90%+ Black, 2 are 80%+ Black
- Longest commutes
- Lowest income
