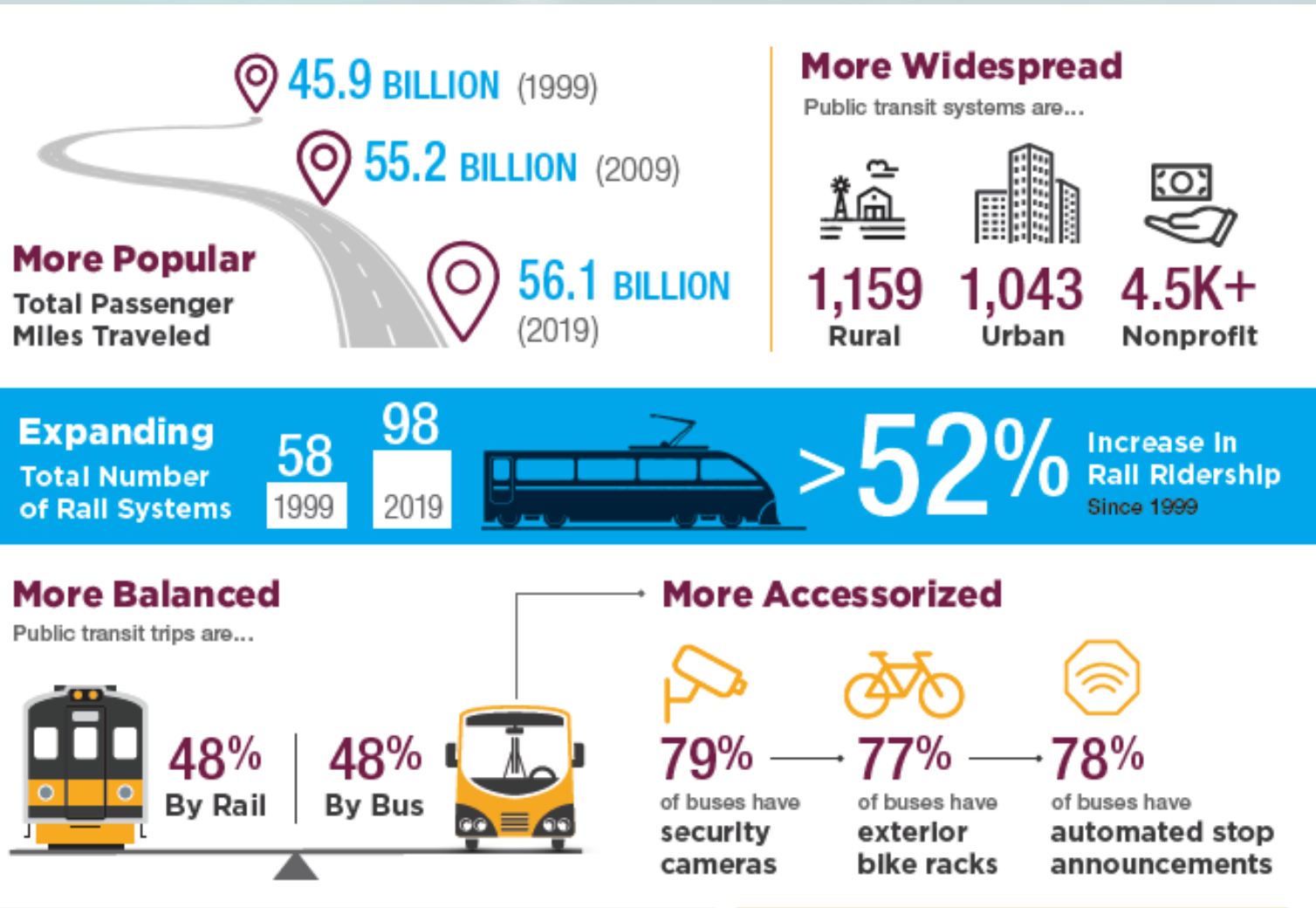

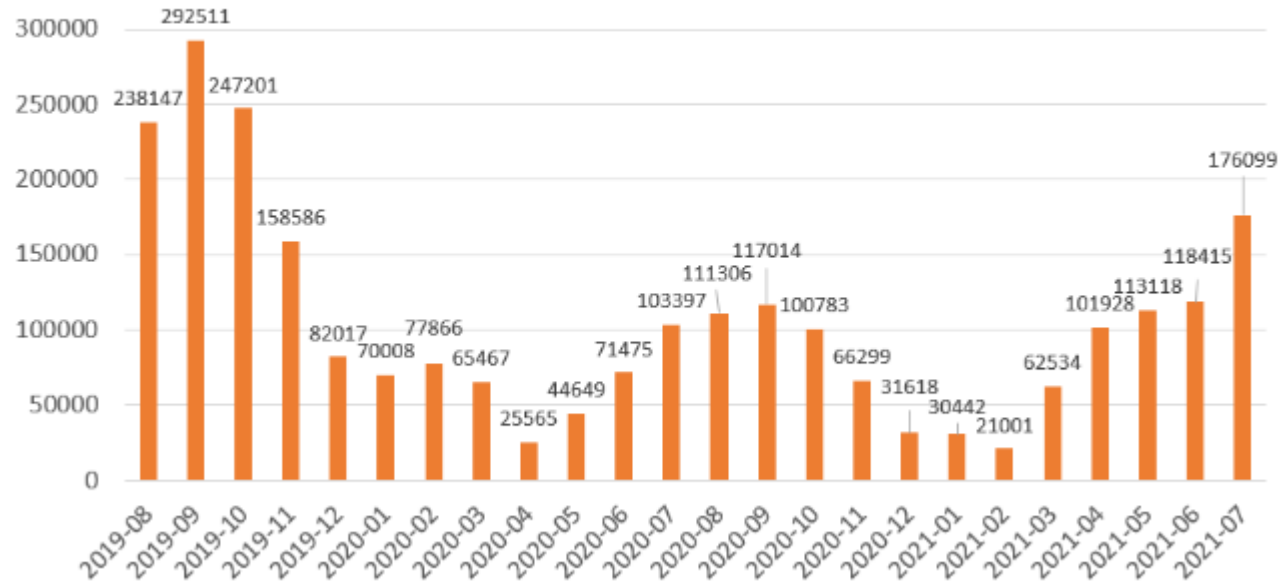

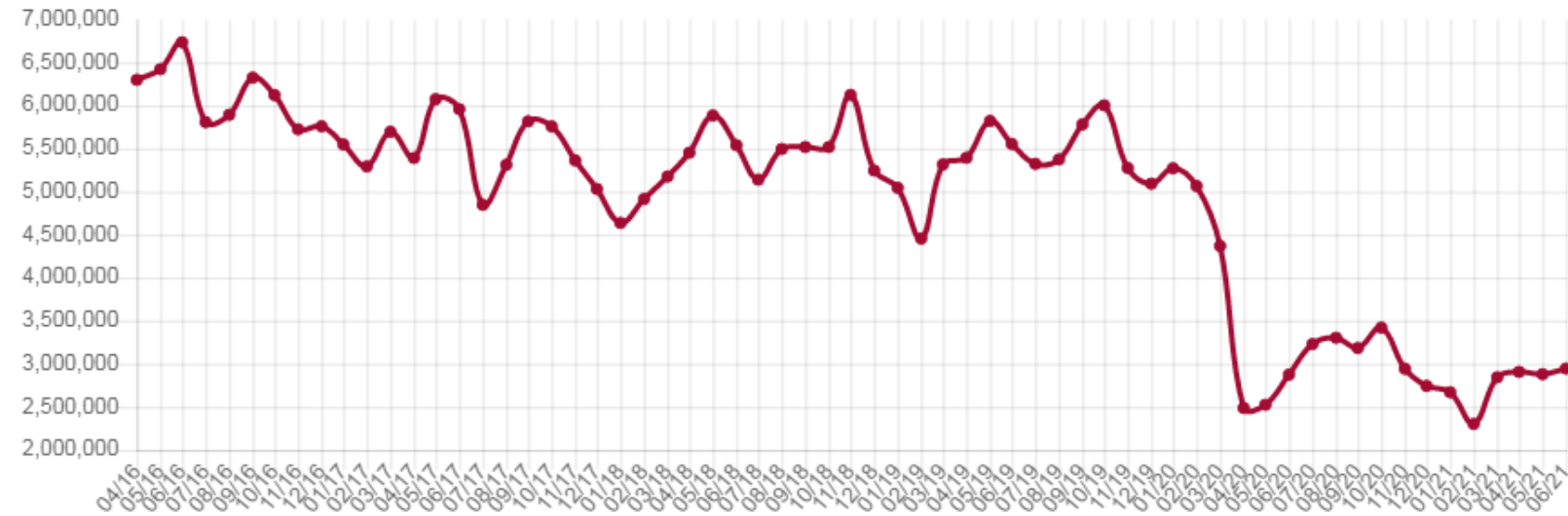
Traditional Transit trending up in 2019

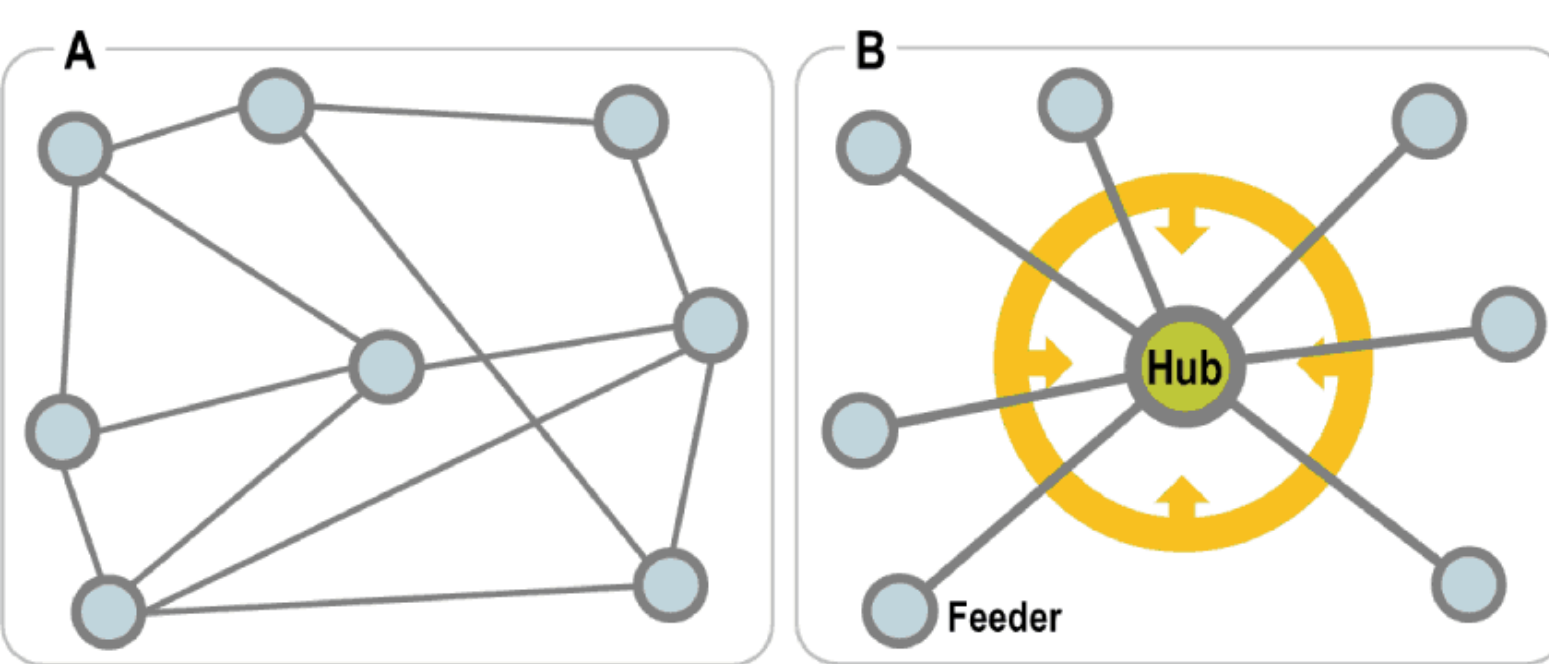
Dockless Vehicle Trips Per Month



Bus (CityLink, LocalLink, Express BusLink) Ridership

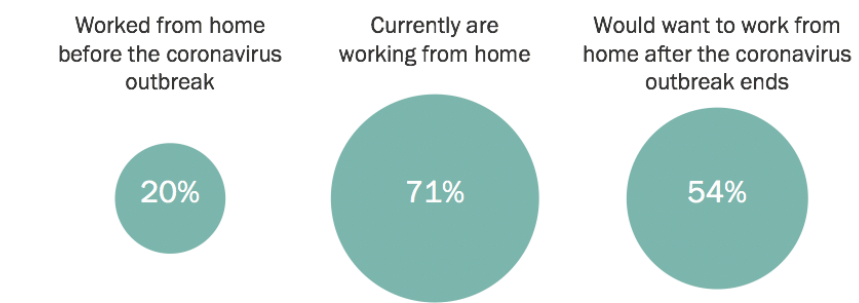


The BC DOT Services: Scooters strong

Among employed adults who say that, for the most part, the responsibilities of their job can be done from home, % saying they ___ all or most of the time



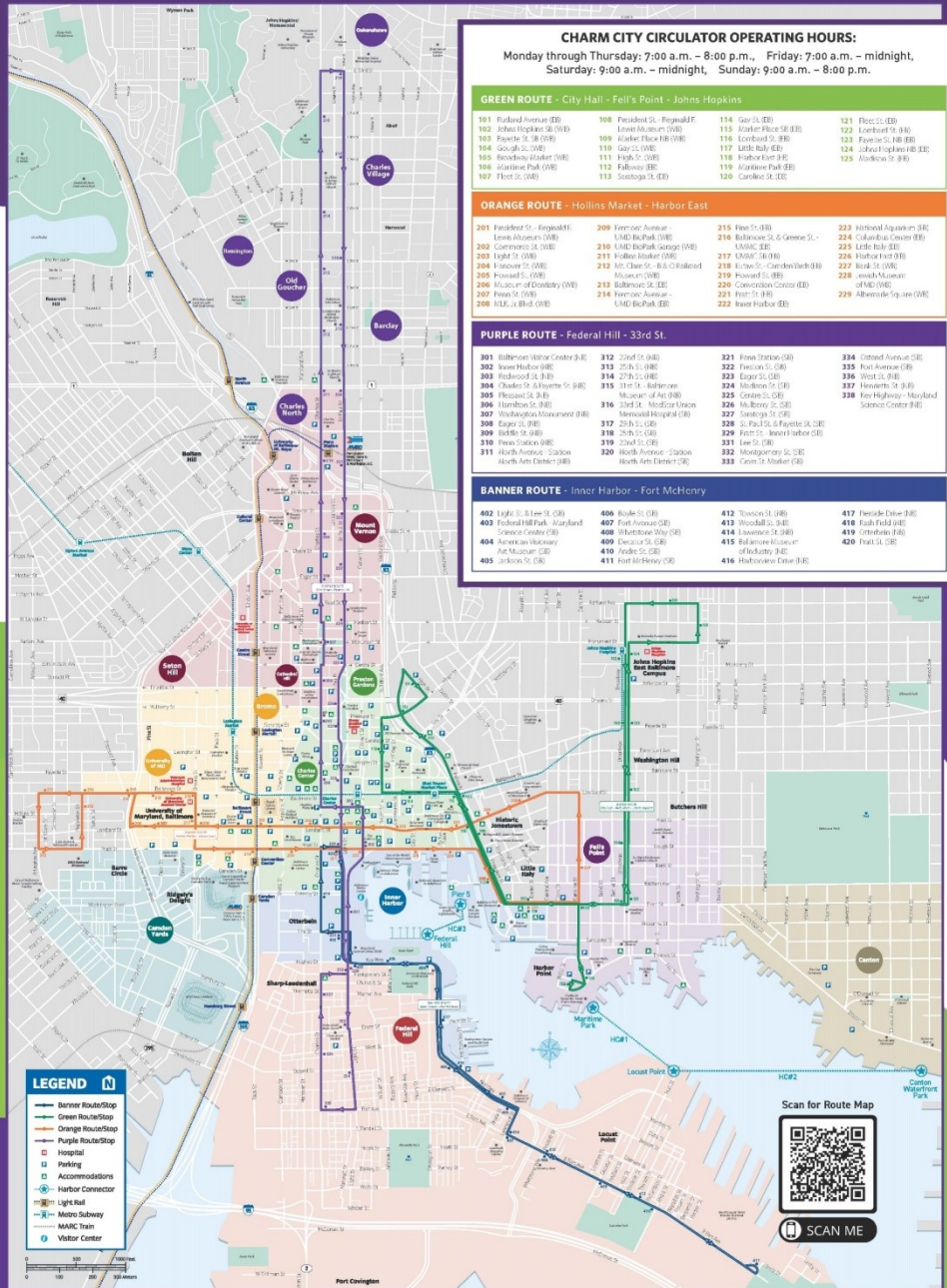
Among employed adults who are currently working from home all or most of the time, % saying that, since the coronavirus outbreak, each of the following has been ___ for them

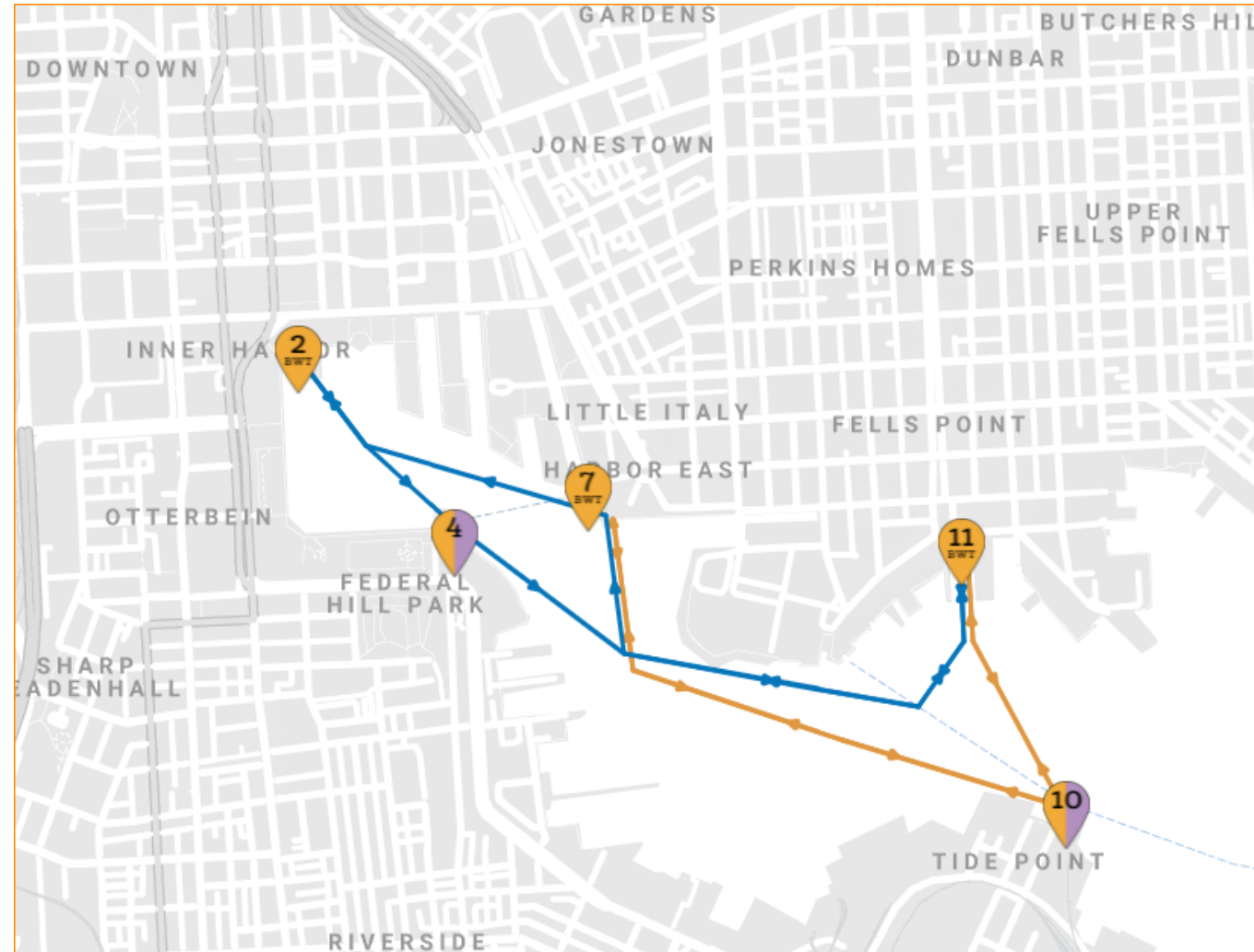

Access to Frequent, All-Day Service for Communities of Concern

Resident or job is within 1/4 mile of a route with service every 15 minutes or better

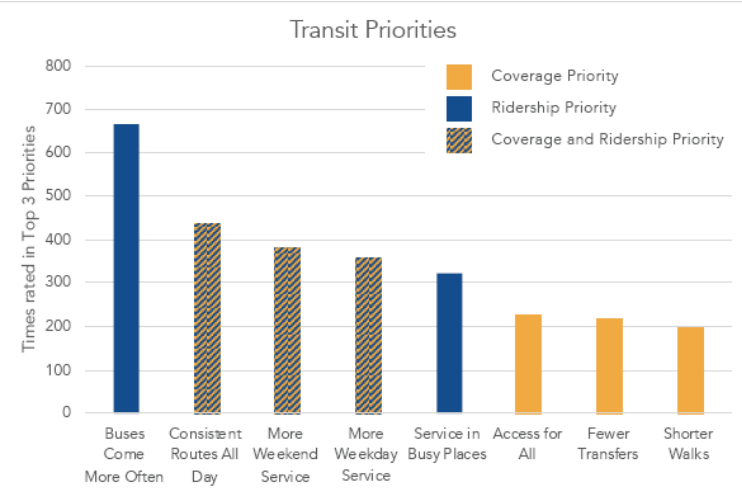
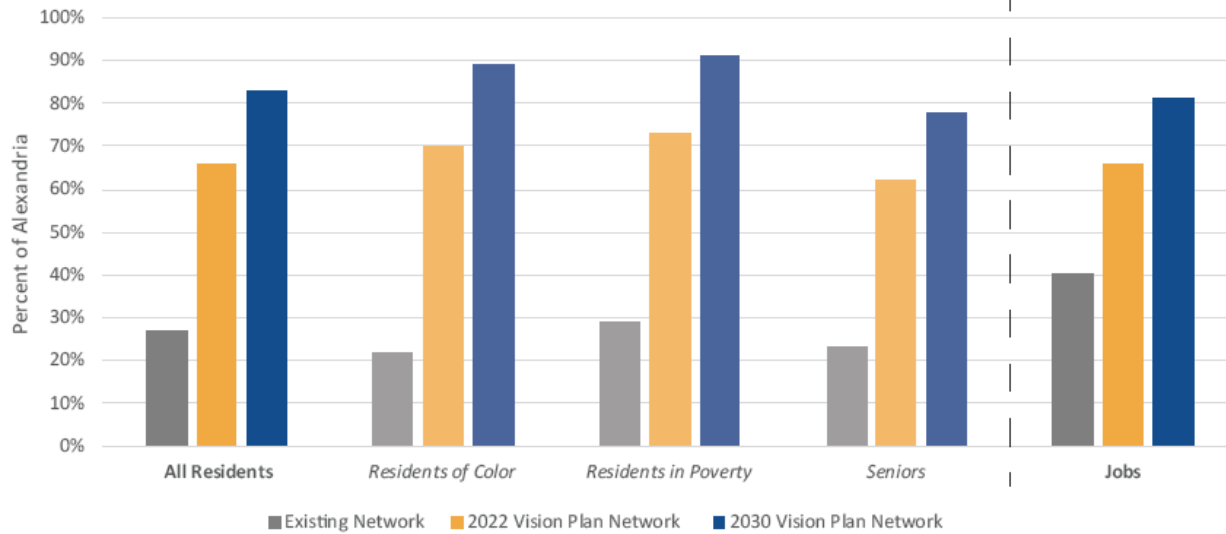


Figure 16: Priorities of survey respondents in Phase 2 Survey

The percent of Alexandria residents near frequent, all-day transit (a bus or train coming every 15 minutes or better) would increase from 27 to 83% by 2030.

99%

The percent of existing bus boardings in Alexandria that will continue to be within 1/8 of a mile of a future bus stop under the new ATV Plan.

+18%

For the average Alexandrian, the number of jobs accessible by transit within 45 minutes would increase by 18% by 2030.

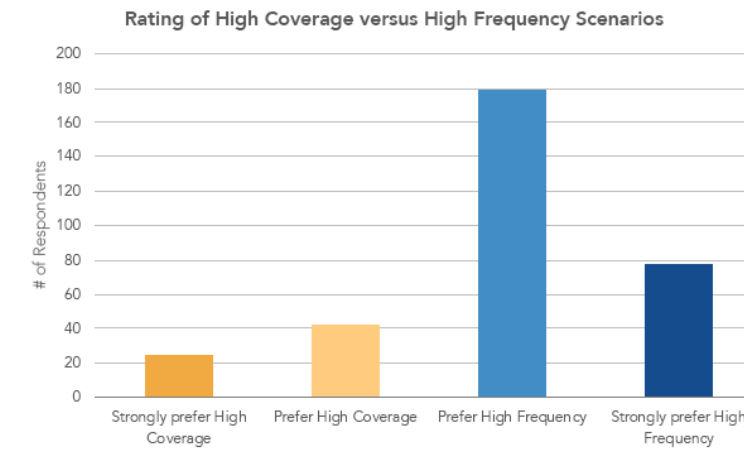
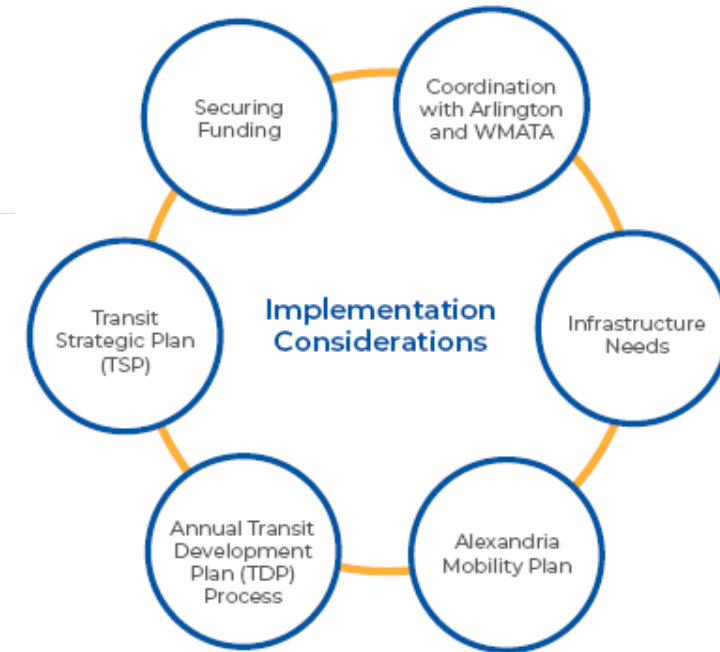


Figure 11: Survey respondents generally said they preferred a High Frequency system.

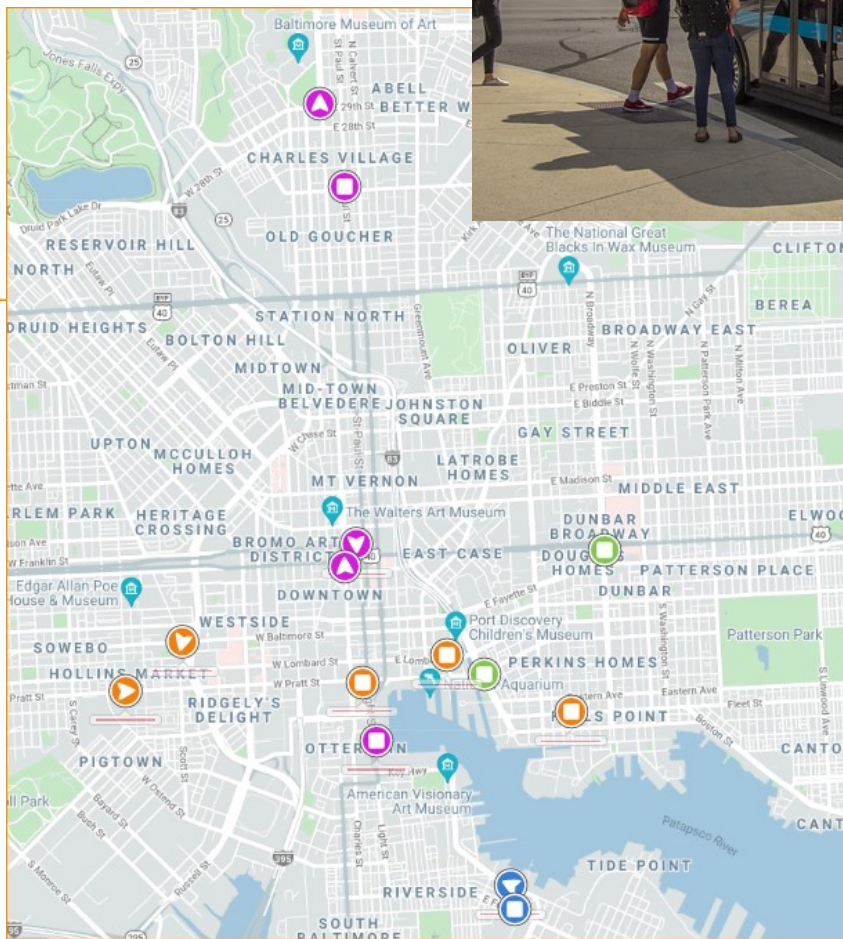

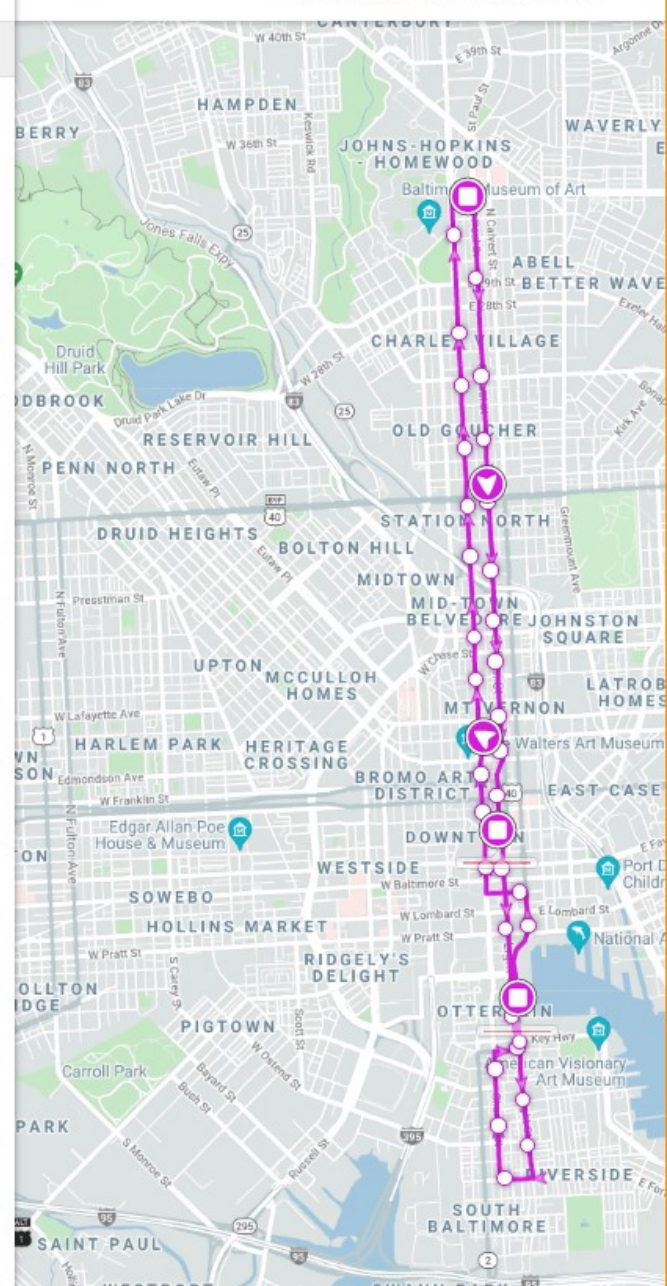
